- - The nominee is a member of an incorporated club or association based in the Bunbury Geographe region, unless the sport does not allow the opportunity to compete as part of a club or association.
 - All nominations must be endorsed by an incorporated club or association, unless the sport does not allow the opportunity to compete within the region.
 - All nominations must include a photo of the nominee (profile or action photo) in a JPEG
